### Examination of Conscience for Adults

"In the life of the body a man is sometimes sick, and unless he takes medicine, he will die. Even so in the spiritual life a man is sick on account of sin. For that reason he needs medicine so that he may be restored to health; and this grace is bestowed in the Sacrament of Penance." -St. Thomas Aquinas

### Prayer Before Examen/Confession

Come Holy Spirit into my soul. Enlighten my mind that I may know the sins I ought to confess, and grant me your grace to confess them fully, humbly and with contrite heart. Help me to firmly resolve not to commit them again. O Blessed Virgin, Mother of my Redeemer, mirror of innocence and sanctity, and refuge of penitent sinners, intercede for me through the Passion of Your Son, that I may obtain the grace to make a good confession. All you blessed Angels and Saints of God, pray for me, a most miserable sinner, that I may repent from my evil ways, that my heart may henceforth be forever united with yours in eternal love. Amen.

#### **Preliminary Notes**

Besides confessing the SIN ITSELF, we must also recollect, as far as possible, the NUMBER of times we have committed them, telling also (and <u>only</u>) those circumstances which at times may either make a venial sin mortal or a mortal sin notably worse. **Mortal sins** are those 1) of grave matter 2) committed with full knowledge and 3) freely consented too.

#### First Commandment: 1 am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods before me.

- Do I strive to love God with my whole heart, mind and soul?
- Have I loved someone or something more than God (money, power, sex, ambition, possessions, etc.)?
- Do I spend time each day in prayer?

Do I nourish and protect my faith?

Have I publically denied a truth of the faith out of concern for the opinion of others?

Have I received the Eucharist in a state of mortal sin?

- Have I committed the sin of presumption, committing a sin while intending to confess it later?
- Have I willfully doubted or denied any of the teachings of the Church (heresy)?

Have I despaired of my salvation or God's mercy? Have I knowingly read any anti-Catholic literature?

Have I knowingly read any anti-Catholic interature? Have I practiced any superstitions/occult and/or put faith in them (horoscopes, fortune tellers, divinization, crystals, Ouija boards, tarot cards,

séances, witchcraft, Charlie Charlie, etc.)?

### Second Commandment: You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

Have I used God's name in vain by way of profanity? Have I murmured or complained against God

(blasphemy)? Have I spoken about the sacred with irreverence (the Faith, the Church and clergy, the saints)?

Have I sworn by God's name either falsely or rashly? Have I broken any private vow?

Have I used vulgar, obscene or suggestive speech?

# Third Commandment: Remember to keep holy the Lord's day.

Have I missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days through my own fault or without a serious reason (illness, care of someone who is ill, etc.)? Have I caused my kids to miss Mass?

Have I been late for Mass through my own negligence? Have I left early?

Have I been inattentive at Mass or otherwise failed in reverence for the Most Blessed Sacrament?

Have I done unnecessary servile work (physical labor) or shopping on Sunday? If an employer, have I required employees to work on Sundays in non-essential occupations?

# ★ Fourth Commandment: Honor your father and your mother.

Have I been disrespectful to, mistreated or neglected my parents? My spouse?

Regarding my children:

- -Have I neglected their material needs?
- -Have I failed their proper religious instruction?
- —Have I allowed them to neglect their religious duties, especially the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Penance?

—Have I given them a bad example?

- Have I failed in obedience or respect to those in authority?
- Have I supported politicians because they are opposed to the teachings of Christ and His Church?

### Fifth Commandment: You shall not kill.

Have I unjustly and intentionally killed anyone?

Have I had an abortion, or assisted with, cooperated in or encouraged one?

Have I considered or attempted suicide? Or mutilated or harmed my own body?

- Have I supported, promoted or assisted in the suicide of another, including "mercy killings"?
- Have I inflicted unjust bodily harm on another? Have I unjustly threatened another person with such?
- Have I verbally or emotionally abused another?
- Have I wished evil upon another?
- Have I been prejudiced or discriminated against another?
- Have I recklessly endangered my health or life or that of another?
- Have I abused alcohol or drugs?
- Have I been gluttonous or otherwise neglected my health?
- Have I encouraged others to sin by giving scandal? Have I helped another commit a mortal sin?
- Have I caused injury or death by criminal neglect? Have I indulged in serious anger or resentment? Have I refused to forgive another?

#### Sixth & Ninth Commandments: You shall not commit adultery. / You shall not desire your neighbor's wife.

- Have I been faithful to my marriage vows in thought and action?
- Have I committed adultery (sex outside of marriage) or fornication (sex before marriage)?
- Have I used artificial contraception/birth control or been sterilized for this purpose, or encouraged others to do so? Have I used IVF?
- Have I engaged in prostitution or with prostitutes?
- Have I touched another impurely?
- Have I masturbated?
- Have I indulged in pornographic magazines, movies or internet websites? Have I watched movies that contain impure scenes for this purpose?
- Have I harbored lustful desires and thoughts?
- Am I chaste in my demonstrations of affection as proper to my state of life?
- Have I failed to dress modestly? Have I done anything to provoke or occasion impure thoughts in others?
- Have I used indecent language or told indecent stories or jokes? Have I willingly listened to such stories?
- Have I boasted of my sins against these Commandments?
- Was I married outside the Church without the blessing of the Church?
- Have I permitted my children or others under my charge to do any of these things?

### / You shall not desire your neighbor's goods.

Have I stolen anything? Have I neglected restitution? Have I damaged or destroyed anyone's property intentionally?

- Have I cheated or defrauded another? On a test, taxes, sports, games or in business?
- Have I squandered money by excessive gambling?
- Have I refused or neglected to pay any debts?
- Have I neglected my duties or been slothful?

Have I given generously to those in need? Am I greedy or selfish? Does my life revolve around material possessions?

Have I envied others because of their possessions? Am I jealous of others because of what they have?

Do I trust that God will care for all of my material and spiritual needs?

# Eighth Commandment: You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Have I quarreled with any one?

- Have I cursed anyone or otherwise wished evil on another?
- Have I taken pleasure in anyone's misfortune?
- Have I lied? Lied about another (calumny)?
- Have I rashly judged anyone in serious matters?

Have I engaged in gossip or spread scandal/the sins of another (detraction)? Have I been a talebearer?

- Have I lent an ear to scandal about my neighbor?
- Have I tried to make reparation for a bad reputation I caused or contributed to, or I lie I told, as far as is possible?

Do I keep secret what should be kept confidential?

### ✤ Precepts of the Church

Have I neglected the Easter duty of receiving Holy Communion or failed to confess my sins at least once a year?

Have I ever failed to confess a serious sin or tried disguised it? Have I lied during Confession?

Have I been guilty of irreverence for this Sacrament by failing to examine my conscience carefully?

- Have I failed to perform the penance given me?
- Have I observed the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence?
- Have I contributed to the support of the Church and Her work? Of my time, talent and treasure?
- Have I observed the laws of the Church concerning marriage?
