

- Get yourself ready by making your examination of conscience, asking the Holy Spirit to help you know your sins.
- 2. After the priest greets you with the Sign of the Cross, make The Sign of the Cross and say: "Bless me Father for I have sinned.

 It has been (say how long) since my last confession. These are my sins..."
- 3. Tell your sins simply and honestly to the priest. Don't be embarrassed.
- 4. When you are done listing your sins say:"...I am sorry for these sins and all the sins I can't remember."
- 5. Listen to the advice the priest gives you and accept the *penance* from him. Then make an <u>Act of Contrition</u> for your sins. This is a prayer that says how sorry you are for your sins.

My God,
I am sorry for my sins with all my heart.
In choosing to do wrong
and failing to do good,
I have sinned against you
Whom I should love above all things.
I firmly intend, with your help,
to do penance, to sin no more,
and to avoid whatever leads me to sin.
Our Savior Jesus Christ
Suffered and died for us.
In His name, my God, have mercy.
Amen.

6. The priest will then pray the *Prayer of Absolution*, and your sins will be forgiven. When you hear him say "I absolve you of your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," make the sign of the cross.

The priest will then conclude with the words: "Go in Peace."

You respond: "Thanks be to God."

7. Perform your penance as soon as possible.
